

McNulty nods to Indiana, gets All-American honor

Ted McNulty, quarterback of the 1968 Golden Bear State Champions, has been named to the All-America, All-Ohio, All-District and All-COL first-place teams.

At the Columbus Touchdown Club in January, Ted became the first recipient of the James A. Rhodes Award as the most outstanding high school football player in the state.

During the Touchdown Club's annual event, Ted had the opportunity to meet and talk with

UCLA's O. J. Simpson and Notre Dame's Terry Hanratty. "My biggest thrill at the Touchdown Club was meeting these people and being on the same level with them," explained Ted.

"I thought O.J. might be a little conceited, but he was really humble and a great guy to talk to," commented Ted.

Ted plans to attend Indiana University next fall, adding that he hopes to visit UA to see the third state championship team.
